SHALLOW SUBSIDY

For eligible Veterans, Shallow Subsidy pays 50% of your rent for up to 24 months. This service was created for Veterans enrolled in the SSVF program who are in need of a longer-term assistance in comparison to our traditional services. Shallow Subsidy equips the Veteran with the necessary support to increase self-sufficiency and further promote housing stability through light case management services and temporary financial assistance.

ELIGIBILITY

SERVED

In the active military, naval, or air service, regardless of length of service, and who was discharged or released therefrom.

Veterans in the Reserves may be eligible if they are Active Duty for Training (ACDUTRA) only. Veterans in the National Guard may be eligible if they have been called to active duty under Title 10.

GROSS ANNUAL HOUSEHOLD INCOME

Less than 50% of Guam's Area Median Income (AMI), based on household size.

HOUSING CRISIS

- Staying in a space not meant for human living (beach, car, park, abandoned building, etc.).
- Staying in a shelter or institution that provides temporary living arrangements.
- Facing imminent loss of current residence within 30 days or less.
- Staying in a "doubled up" or a "couch surfing" situation.
